### Regional Source

Sourced predominantly from the Riverland with a proportion from the Barossa Valley.

### Grape Variety

Grenache, Shiraz (Syrah)

### Maturation

This wine has no maturation or contact with oak as it is for early consumption, while fresh.

### Colour

Pale pink.



### Nose

Good varietal Grenache aromas of cherry, strawberry with a touch of spice.



### Palate

A light berry fruit driven style Rose, which shows cherry fruit flavours. A dry, soft palate of medium but pleasing weight flows through to a clean, crisp finish. Great balance and a juicy finish, and great summer drinking
