### Colour

Bright crimson with ruby hues.



### Nose

Rich red berry aromas with touches of cedarwood and spice.



### Palate

A generous, supple wine on the palate with red and dark berry fruit flavours and hints of chocolate. Soft oak spice and juicy natural acidity complete the offering and provide for a long, generous finish.
