## Bin 99 Pinot Noir 2016

Loved around the world, Lindeman's Bin Series wines are approachable in style, consistent in quality with global appeal. Designed to be opened, enjoyed and shared time and time again, these are wines people simply love to drink.

Lindeman's most well-known range began with the iconic Lindeman's Bin 65 Chardonnay, which was first launched in 1985 in response to the popularity of Lindeman's approachable and fruit-driven style of wines in the northern hemisphere.

Lindeman's Bin 99 Pinot Noir is a medium bodied wine featuring aromas of cherry and red berry fruits with a vanillin oak lift, with the palate displays a mixture of cherry fruits, with a creamy texture with a light tannin structure.

### Winemaker Comments: Wayne Falkenberg

**Vintage Conditions:** Temperatures were significantly warmer than average during the spring and summer months. These weather conditions caused bud bursts to occur at the usual time, but vine growth and development rapidly increased with flowering, veraison and harvest dates occurring earlier than ever before on most vineyards.

A dry winter and spring with little effective rainfall resulted in reliance on irrigation with little disease incidence. 2016 vintage wines will be rated as good, if not better, than the great 2015 vintage.

**Grape Variety:** Pinot Noir

**Maturation:** French & American oak

**Colour:** Dark crimson red in colour

**Nose:** Ripe cherry and blueberry fruits with a vanillin oak lift and a hint of spice

**Palate:** Rich fruit up front, red berries and dark cherry with a very fine tannin structure giving length and texture to the wine. Sweet spice and savoury complexity in mid palate. A clean, bright finish with natural acidity and complexing toasty characters.



**Vineyard Region:** South Eastern Australia

**Harvest Date:** March 2016

**Wine Analysis:** Alc/Vol: 13.0%, Acidity: 5.8g/L, pH: 3.57

**Bottling Date:** August 2016

**Peak Drinking:** Best enjoyed young and fresh

**Food Match:** Enjoy with duck confit and creamy potato mash
